

**Subject :** PROVISION OF FUNDS FOR PRINTING AND REPRODUCTION OF  
ALTERNATIVE LEARNING SYSTEM K to 12 BASIC EDUCATION  
CURRICULUM LEARNING RESOURCES

**Date :** April 4, 2022

The Department of Education (DepEd), through the Bureau of Alternative Education (BAE) shall provide funds for the printing and reproduction of Alternative Learning System (ALS) K to 12 Basic Education Curriculum (BEC) Learning Resources. This is following the issuance of DepEd Order No. 12, s. 2022 on the Policy Guidelines for the Provision of Learning Resources and Needed Devices and Equipment and Funding Relevant Activities for the Implementation of the Basic Education Learning Continuity Plan (BE-LCP).

**Section V of DepEd Order No. 12, s. 2022**, in particular Letter A. – Item 1 states that:

“1. For the Alternative Learning System (ALS) program, the ready-to-print copies of ALS K to 12 BEC-aligned learning resources shall be made available to all ALS Regional Focal Persons, through Google drive.

The Assistant Secretary for the Alternative Learning System shall issue a separate Office Memorandum to identify the ALS K to 12 BEC-aligned learning resources for printing, reproduction, and delivery for the corresponding School Year”.

In compliance, the BAE shall download funds to the Regional Offices (ROs) for the printing, and reproduction of the following:

1. [50 NEW ALS Junior High School Modules](#) (developed with support of KOICA and UNESCO Jakarta);
2. [Self-Directed Learning Modules](#) ; and
3. [Life Skills Modules](#) .

Kindly refer to the Attachment No. 1 for the specific amount to be downloaded per RO. The number of copies to be printed per ALS LR is based on the number of ALS Teachers registered in the Learner Information System (LIS).

This is to reiterate **Items 2 and 3 of Section V, Letter A of DepEd Order No. 12, s. 2022**:

“2. Unauthorized printing, uploading, reproduction, distribution, and such other unlawful actions that involve or relate to the sharing of digital files other than to the intended recipients and for the intended purpose are strictly prohibited and shall be grounds for the imposition of administrative sanctions, without prejudice to the filing of other appropriate administrative, civil, and criminal actions”.

“3. In the production of SLMs and ALS LRs, the technical specifications provided under Joint Memorandum No. DM-OUCI-2021-261 dated July 8, 2021 shall be adopted. This is without prejudice to other specifications that may hereinafter be issued by the Office of the Undersecretary for Curriculum and Instruction and the Office of the Undersecretary for Finance.

All other provisions of DepEd Order No. 12, s. 2022, related and applicable to the printing, reproduction, and delivery of the identified ALS LRs shall apply.




