

GUIDELINES FOR THE CONDUCT OF THE 2023 WORLD FOOD DAY NATIONAL AND REGIONAL ON-THE-SPOT POSTER MAKING CONTESTS

The Department of Agriculture (DA) is honored and privileged to once again partner with the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (FAO) in celebrating this year's World Food Day (WFD).

The annual Poster Making Contest has been one of the highlights of the WFD celebration, in coordination with the Department of Education (DepEd). The activity will involve elementary pupils from Grades V and VI, who are enrolled in any public and Dep-Ed-accredited private elementary schools nationwide.

The WFD Poster Making contest in the Regional level will be conducted On-the-Spot from August to September 2023 in their respective regions. All entries (one entry per region) should be submitted on or before October 4, at 4:00 P.M. The National judging of the submitted regional entries will be on October 5, 2023 in Quezon City.

The following is the set of guidelines for the said event:

I. General Provisions (Regional and National level)

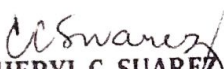
1. The contest is open to all Grades V to VI elementary pupils enrolled in any public and DepEd-accredited private schools nationwide. Previous national winners of this contest are disqualified to join.
2. Pupils shall be allowed to have one (1) coach or one (1) guardian.
3. The poster making contest shall be conducted on-the-spot at the regional level. (Division/District level contest may be conducted provided that expenses to be incurred shall be shouldered by the DepEd or DA regional offices).
4. Contestants are not allowed to bring their own materials. Materials to be used for the Poster Making Contest shall be limited to an illustration board (20" x 30"), oil pastel and pentel pen to be provided by the Contest Committee during the regional contests.
5. The poster should be an original creation of the contestant depicting the given theme of the contest, which will be written outside, and not incorporated in the artwork. Contestants who will not follow instructions will automatically be disqualified.
6. Only one (1) entry per region should be endorsed by the Regional On-the-Spot Poster Making Contest Committee as official entry to the National level.
7. All official entries from the regional level must be submitted to the Department of Agriculture thru the Agriculture and Fisheries Information Division (DA-AFID), Elliptical Road, Diliman, Quezon City.
8. The national judging of the regional entries will be held at the DA Central Office on October 5, 2023.
9. The BOJ shall select the Best 5 posters from among the entries.
10. The decision of the BOJ shall be final and irrevocable. However, if the winner has been proven to commit any misconduct (i.e. plagiarism, or any form of cheating), the title and the prize shall be withdrawn.
11. All entries shall become the property of the DA and FAO.
12. Winning entries will be displayed during the culminating activities of the WFD Celebration on October 16, 2023 in Quezon City. Best Posters will be awarded on the same event.
13. Winners of the Best Poster will receive a cash prize, trophy, and a certificate of recognition.

II. **Criteria for Judging:**

Only the Best Five (5) Posters shall be selected as National Winners based on the following criteria:

a. Originality -----	30%
b. Creativity -----	30%
c. Visual Impact -----	20%
d. Relevance to the theme -----	20%
Total -----	100%
