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**INVITATION TO THE 2025 NATIONAL LEADERSHIP ENHANCEMENT AND
DEVELOPMENT SEMINAR (NLEAD) OF THE PHILIPPINE SOCIETY OF

The Philippine Society of Youth Science Clubs (PSYSC), Inc., Is a nationwide organization dedicated to upholding the spirit of science clubbing and promoting the public understanding of science, technology, and the environment (PUSTE). For over 54 years, PSYSC has consistently conducted impactful activities and programs tailored for elementary and high school students. Our aim is to empower the youth, ignite their interest in science and technology, and foster a deeper awareness of environmental and social issues.

One of the organization's events is the annual National Leadership Enhancement and Development Seminar (NLEAD), a four day-long training-seminar event designed to equip and prepare highly capable student-leaders from each region who are committed and passionate in serving their Regional Councils. NLEAD is conducted to enhance the knowledge and skills of young leaders on planning, implementation, and assessment of activities that are both educational and enjoyable while still aiming to promote public understanding of science, technology, and the environment (PUSTE).
