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**INVITATION TO RESPOND TO THE ONLINE SURVEY FOR TEC PROJECT T25
BY THE SCP TEACHERS IN REGION 12**

This is in reference to the TEC Advisory No. 02, s.2026, dated April 21, 2026, which endorses the data-gathering activities for the Research Initiatives in Teacher Education Year 2 (RITE 2), namely, an online survey for teachers handling Special Curricular Programs (SCPs) of the Department of Education (DepEd).

The study listed under Project Code T25, entitled: "Examining the Intended and Implemented Special Curricular Programs of the Department of Education Towards Policy Recommendations." The project is implemented by the Teacher Education Council (TEC), in partnership with the University of Santo Tomas as the Project Management Team, and with Mindanao State University - General Santos and the University of Santo Tomas, Manila as implementing institutions for T25.

All responses will be treated with strict confidentiality and used solely for research and policy recommendation purposes.
