**PARTICIPATION IN THE NCCA-PCEP PAGSASANAY SA EDUKASYONG
PANGKULTURA (PEP) 2026**

The National Commission for Culture and the Arts (NCCA) through the Philippine Cultural Education Program (PCEP) announces the conduct of **“Pagsasanay sa Edukasyong Pangkultura (PEP).”** The training program will take place from **July 10–12, 2026 (Friday to Sunday) at the Metropolitan Theater Ballroom, Padre Burgos Avenue**, corner Antonio Villegas St., Ermita, **Manila**.

Anchored on this year's theme, "Developing Filipino Identity in the Arts," the seminar-training aims to strengthen cultural awareness and establish cultural competencies among educators using a culture-based pedagogical approach.

This program is specifically inviting the newly hired DepEd ARTS teachers and DepEd teachers who have not previously attended any PCEP training. It is also open to all 2026 Level I GDCE and GDTA scholars from La Consolacion University Philippines and the University of Cebu, as well as prospective scholars interested for 2027. Additionally, public school administrators, principals, and supervisors are encouraged to participate.

To manage the delegation efficiently, each Schools Division Office (SDO) may endorse a maximum quota per school/institution as follows:

- One Supervisor-level representative
- One Principal-level representative
- Two Teacher-participants

It is further emphasized that participation in this activity is purely voluntary and subject to official approval, and **NO GOVERNMENT FUNDS SHALL BE UTILIZED for any expenses related to travel, accommodation, meals, and other incidental costs.** Any expenses that may be incurred shall be shouldered by the concerned participants or sponsoring institution.

This issuance is made in strong adherence to the **No Disruption of Classes policy. Likewise**, the official time and attendance arrangement shall be determined by the Schools Division Superintendent.

This activity is open to newly hired ARTS DepEd teachers; DepEd teachers who have *not previously attended* any PCEP-organized conference, seminar, or training program; all 2026 Level I scholars of the Graduate Diploma in Cultural Education (GDCE) and Graduate Diploma in Teaching Arts (GDTA) from La Consolacion University Philippines and University of Cebu; interested GDCE and GDTA scholars for 2027; and administrators, principals, and supervisors from public schools.

Each institution is allowed to endorse and nominate a maximum of one (1) supervisor level, one (1) principal level, and two (2) teacher-participants. Interested applicants may apply online using this link: <https://tinyurl.com/5ekp94at>.

Also, the National Association of Cultural Educators & Scholars (NACES) officers will participate to (1) conduct a survey on cultural awareness, the culture-based approach, and cultural competencies; (2) promote NACES membership; and (3) assist during the 3-day activity.
