**DISSEMINATION OF AVAILABLE SOURCES OF LEARNING RESOURCES
DURING DISASTERS AND EMERGENCIES**

To: Schools Division Superintendents

1. To ensure the continuity of learning during emergencies, this Office informs all Schools Division Offices (SDOs) and schools of the available sources of learning resources.

2. Schools and teachers are encouraged to utilize and access the following official learning resource repositories:

- a. **DepEd Learning Resources (LR) Portal** <https://lrmds.deped.gov.ph/> – Repository of quality-assured learning resources, including textbooks, modules, activity sheets, and multimedia materials.
- b. **Learning Packets for Disasters and Emergencies** <https://tinyurl.com/LRPACKETS> - Self-paced, modular learning materials provided by the Department of Education to ensure students can continue their education during calamities, disasters and emergencies.
- c. **DepEd Commons** – Online platform providing digital learning materials aligned with the K to 12 Curriculum.

- g. Other Division and school-developed quality-assured learning resources approved by the Department of Education and aligned with the K to 12 curriculum.

3. Schools Division Offices and schools are advised to:

- a. assess the availability and condition of learning resources in affected schools;
- b. facilitate the redistribution or sharing of available learning resources among schools, where feasible;
- c. coordinate with the Regional Office through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) for technical assistance and additional resource requirements; and



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- d. submit reports on learning resource shortages and interventions undertaken, as may be required.
4. Division LRMS and School heads shall ensure that teachers maximize available digital and printed learning resources and adopt appropriate strategies to sustain learning delivery.
