In celebration of the 126th Philippine Civil Service Anniversary (PCSA) this September with the theme "*Bawat Kawani, Lingkod Bayani: Puso, Dangal, at Galing Para sa Bayan*" a **2026 PCSA Fun Run**, is lined-up as one of the major activities dubbed "*Lingkod Bayani Run 2026: Stride as One, Serve the Nation (Sama-samang Hakbang, Serbisyo Para sa Bayan)*".

The Fun Run activity spearheaded by the Civil Service Commission RO XII will be held on **13 September 2026 (Sunday) 4:00 a.m.** at the City Hall Grounds, Koronadal City.

This activity aims to raise funds and create awareness of the Pamanang Lingkod Bayani of the Civil Service Commission as well as promote health and wellness among civil servants.

Proceeds from the activity will go directly to the Pamanang Lingkod Bayani (PLBi), a fund dedicated to supporting the families of public servants who died in the line of duty. Since 2011, a total of 246 beneficiaries have received one-time financial assistance of Php100,000.00 each. Additionally, the children of PLBi awardees are recommended for scholarships at state universities and colleges.

We request the support of your agency by sending interested officials, employees and other parties to participate in this meaningful activity. A registration fee of P350.00 (3K Wellness Run), P600.00 (5K Unity Run) and P800.00 (10K Lingkod Bayani Elite Run) will be charged per participant depending on the category.

In alignment with the provisions of CSC-DBM Joint Circular No. 2, s. of 2004 as amended, *heads of offices are authorized to issue directives granting a one-day compensatory Overtime Credit (COC) to employees participating in CSC-organized PCSA activities occurring on non-working days. The authority to grant such COCs is vested in the heads of offices, who are responsible for determining the necessity and validity of overtime services rendered in accordance with the guidelines set forth in the joint circular.*
