INSTITUTE (DOST-SEI) 2027 UNDERGRADUATE SCHOLARSHIPS PROGRAM**

The Department of Science and Technology-Science Education Institute (DOST-SEI) is now accepting online applications for the 2027 Undergraduate Scholarships Program through this link: <https://science-scholarships.ph/>.

There are two (2) program categories to which students may apply:

1) RA 7687 scholarship, otherwise known as the S&T Scholarship Act of 1994, which provides scholarships to talented students whose family's socio-economic status does not exceed the set values of certain indicators as approved by the Advisory Committee on S&T Scholarships; and

2) the DOST-SEI Merit Scholarships awarded to deserving students whose socio-economic status exceeds the said indicators.

Application is open to Grade 12 students in the STEM strand and to non-STEM Grade 12 students provided they belong to the top 5% of their graduating class in Academic Year 2026- 2027. Applicants should pass the examination on November 14 - 15, 2026 and pursue a 4- or 6-year Bachelor of Science (BS) degree program in any of the priority fields of study at a state university or college or any private higher education institution that is recognized by the Commission on Higher Education as Center of Excellence or Center of Development or with at least FAAP Level III accreditation for the BS program that they intend to enroll in.

Qualifiers who will avail the scholarship will receive financial assistance in the form of monthly living allowance of PhP8,000.00/month, learning materials and/or connectivity allowance of PhP5,000.00/semester, outright grant for prescribed Physical Education uniform of PhP1,000.00 for the first semester of the first year only, tuition fees subsidy not to exceed PhP20,000/semester, additional privileges during summer (monthly living allowance during the period, learning materials and/or connectivity allowance of PhP2,000, tuition and other school fees not to exceed PhP10,000.00). Other privileges include group health and accident insurance, post-graduation clothing allowance of PhP1,000, and Thesis allowance of PhP10,000.00.

Fully accomplished application forms and complete requirements must be submitted online or before **September 17, 2026**.
