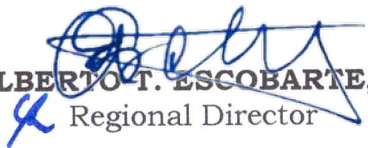

1. In line with the Department's commitment to strengthening the Learner Rights and Protection (LRP) mechanism, **all public and private elementary and secondary schools** are hereby directed to submit their school-level data on Children at Risk (CAR) and Children in Conflict with the Law (CICL) for the School Year 2025-2026.
2. This data collection is crucial for the school Child Protection Committees' vital role as part of the multidisciplinary team mandated under Department Order No. 18, s. 2015, which institutionalizes clear protocols for the protection and management of Children at Risk (CAR) and Children in Conflict with the Law (CICL) within the basic education system. Accurate and timely data tracking is essential for mapping appropriate interventions, safeguarding learners, and ensuring a protective environment across all schools.
3. In this regard, school-level reports must be consolidated by the SDO LRP focal persons **on or before August 31, 2026**. The SDO shall validate and consolidate the school-level reports, and submit the final signed report to the Regional Office via email at learnershelpline.ro12@deped.gov.ph using the exact subject line: *[SDO Name] _CAR-CICL Data_SY 25-26*.
