REGION MEMORANDUM FTAD No. 13, s. 2021

#### CONDUCT OF SBM VALIDATION AND PROVISION OF TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE TO SELECTED SCHOOLS IN DEPED SOCCSKSARGEN REGION

TO: Schools Division Superintendents

Attn: SGOD Chief, Division SBM Coordinator & Division SBM Coordinating Teams (DSCTs) & Regional SBM Coordinating Teams (RSCTs)

1. Relative to Region Memorandum FTAD No. 10, s. 2021 re: "Submission of Status of Division SBM Level of Practice of Schools and Request for Regional Office Validation, this office will conduct a series of SBM Validation to schools endorsed by the Schools Division Superintendents starting May 2021 and onwards. The number of schools to be validated shall be based on the SDO DEDP/Strategic Objectives. All schools endorsed by the SDOs shall have undergone first the validation in the districts and division levels.

2. The validation is generally aimed to establish the quality assurance and technical assistance mechanisms of DepEd SOCCSKSARGEN to all schools. Specifically, it aims to:

- a. Assess the schools endorsed by the SDO by validating their existing SBM practices based on two aspects: School Improvement on Key Performance Indicators (KPIs) on Access, Efficiency and Quality (60%) and SBM Practices based on four (4) principles: Leadership & Governance, Curriculum & Instruction, Accountability & Continuous Improvement, and Resource Management (40%);
- b. Integrate quality assurance mechanisms in ensuring that all DepEd policies, programs & projects (PPPs) are properly implemented in the school level; and
- c. Provide technical assistance for the continuous improvement of schools being validated based on the major findings and to fully capacitate the Division SBM Coordinating Team (DSCT) as well on the SBM Validation Process.

3. The determination of modalities and approaches of the validation shall be based on the actual situation of the schools. All schools to be validated are advised to comply the following requirements:

- A. Compliance to Health Protocol (for limited face to face)
  - School to secure permit to conduct limited face to face validation activity from the city/municipal IATF.







- Steady standby of medical personnel during the validation is required.
- There must be separate rooms per principle. Only 5 participants plus 1 or 2 certified validators are only allowed inside the room. Each must have medical certificate from the City/Municipal Health Unit.
- Ensure the wearing of face mask and face shield at all times as well as the washing of hands with clean water and soap or alcohol.
- CHO/MHO to conduct site inspection and disinfection before the actual conduct of the validation
- B. For online validation:
  - Each SDO/school shall install an online/electronic document management system that will provide the validators easy access to documents/MOVs.
  - Documents shall be forwarded to the region two (2) days before the actual validation. These also include videos on school tour and learning resources.
  - School shall forward a link to the RSCTs one (1) day before the actual validation.
- C. Validation Proper
  - Part 1. Preliminaries: To include short Opening Program and introduction of the participants;
  - Part 2. Conduct of Document Analysis-Observation Discussion (DOD) process
  - Part 3. Closing Program: To include provision of general feedback and awarding of certificate of recognition vis-à-vis SBM Level of Practice achieved.

4. To ensure successful conduct of this process, technical assistance (TA) may be provided when needed. As such, TA report shall be submitted to FTAD. As part of the RO directions of upholding customer satisfaction, all RO and SDO personnel who are involved in the conduct of the SBM Validation, if scheduled on weekends, shall be granted with Compensatory Time Off (CTO) after complying all the necessary requirements.

5. The transportation, accommodation, travelling and other incidental expenses incurred by the participants and concerned schools to be validated shall be charged against local funds/MOOE of their respective offices subject to the usual accounting and auditing procedures and regulations.







6. List of schools to be validated and assigned RSCT is found in the enclosure. There shall be no extravagant preparations, no funfare and no suspension of classes in the conduct of the district, division and regional validation.
